Pew research reports that music is a primary issue affecting the dissatisfaction of Catholics in the United States. We believe this is driven by diminished musical excellence, scattered understanding of the role of music in the Mass and beyond, and a lack of training for musicians. When a music ministry forgets its purpose, the worship and devotion of the whole parish is adversely affected.

How do we **build a culture of devotion** at the parish? They come for Sunday morning Mass, but I'm not sure they'll come again during the week to pray.


